SUBCOMMITTEE ACTION

The Committee on Homeland Security's Subcommittee on Border and Maritime Security met, pursuant to notice, in open markup session, a quorum being present, on Tuesday, March 27, 2012, in 311 Cannon House Office Building to consider the following measure: H.R. 4251, To authorize, enhance, and reform certain port security programs through increased efficiency and risk-based coordination within the Department of Homeland Security, and for other purposes.

The Subcommittee took the following actions:

H.R. 4251, To authorize, enhance, and reform certain port security programs through increased efficiency and risk-based coordination within the Department of Homeland Security, and for other purposes; was reported to the Full Committee with a favorable recommendation, as amended, by voice vote.

The Subcommittee agreed to H.R. 4251, as amended, by voice vote.

The following amendments were offered:

An Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 4251 offered by Mrs. Miller (#1); was AGREED TO, as amended, by voice vote.

A unanimous consent request by Mrs. Miller to consider the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute as base text for purposes of amendment was not objected to.

An amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 4251 offered by Mr. Rigell (#1A); Add at the end a new title entitled "Title ___—Miscellaneous Provisions. Sec. _01. Recognition of Port Security Assessments Conducted by Other Entities."; was AGREED TO by voice vote.

An amendment to the Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 4251 offered by Mr. McCaul (#1B); Add at the end a new title entitled "Title ___—Miscellaneous Provisions. Sec. _01. Limitation on Delegation of Inspection, Certification, and Related Services."; was AGREED TO by voice vote.

Without objection, the Chair authorized staff to make technical and conforming corrections to H.R. 4251.
