

AMENDMENT TO H.R. _____
OFFERED BY MS. JACKSON LEE OF TEXAS

Strike section 262 and insert the following:

1 **SEC. 262. SECURITY DIRECTIVES REVIEW.**

2 (a) AVIATION SECURITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE RE-
3 VIEW.—Section 114(1)(2) of title 49, United States Code,
4 is amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(C) REVIEW BY AVIATION SECURITY AD-
6 VISORY COMMITTEE.—Not later than 30 days
7 after enactment of this Act and regularly there-
8 after, the Assistant Secretary for Homeland Se-
9 curity (Transportation Security Administration)
10 shall transmit on an annual basis to the Advi-
11 sory Committee established under section 282
12 of the Transportation Security Administration
13 Authorization Act of 2011 a list of all security
14 directives in effect for more than 180 days for
15 review and comment from impacted regulated
16 entities within the Advisory Committee.”.

In section 44946 of title 49, United States Code, as
proposed by be added by section 282 of the bill, add at
the end the following:

1 “(f) REVIEW OF SECURITY DIRECTIVES.—

2 “(1) PROVISION OF COMMENTS.—Advisory
3 Committee members directly impacted by security
4 directives in effect for more than six months issued
5 in accordance with section 114(l)(2) of this title may
6 provide comments to the Assistant Secretary for
7 Homeland Security (Transportation Security Admin-
8 istration) on such security directives not later than
9 90 days after the Assistant Secretary for Homeland
10 Security’s (Transportation Security Administration)
11 annual transmission of security directives to the Ad-
12 visory Committee.

13 “(2) CONSIDERATION.—The Assistant Sec-
14 retary for Homeland Security (Transportation Secu-
15 rity Administration) shall consider comments from
16 Advisory Committee members impacted by security
17 directives in effect for more than 180 days and may
18 make changes, based on recommendations submitted
19 in accordance with paragraph (1), or any other fac-
20 tors, to existing security directives issued in accord-
21 ance with section 114(l)(2)(A) of this title.

22 “(3) REPORTING.—The Assistant Secretary, on
23 an annual basis, shall report to the appropriate con-
24 gressional committees, including the Committee on
25 Homeland Security of the House of Representatives,

1 n the status of the security directives, including
2 comments provided by the Advisory Committee on
3 specific security directives.”.
