

En Bloc AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2658

OFFERED BY Ms. Richardson of CA.

In section 2(a), in the quoted section 241(a), strike paragraph (10) and insert the following:

1 “(10) SUITABILITY OF CONTRACT GUARDS.—
2 The Director shall ensure that background investiga-
3 tions are conducted for each contract guard em-
4 ployed at facilities protected by the Federal Protec-
5 tive Service for the purpose of identifying individuals
6 who may pose a threat to Federal facility security,
7 to national security, or terrorism, that shall include,
8 at a minimum, a check against—
9 “(A) relevant Federal criminal history
10 databases;
11 “(B) the consolidated terrorist watchlist;
12 and
13 “(C) in the case of an alien (as defined in
14 section 101 of the Immigration and Nationality
15 Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(3))), the relevant data-
16 bases to determine the status of the alien under
17 the immigration laws of the United States.



AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2658

OFFERED BY MS. RICHARDSON OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of section 2(a), before the closing quotation marks, insert the following (and correct the quoted table of sections in section 2(b) accordingly):

1 **“SEC. 247. HOTLINE.**

2 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Director shall establish a
3 toll-free hotline telephone number for an individual includ-
4 ing, a contract guard, tenant, and visitor to a Federal fa-
5 cility protected by the Federal Protective Service, to anon-
6 ymously report security violations, security lapses, or other
7 suspicious activity at that facility to the Federal Protective
8 Service for situational awareness.

9 “(b) DISPLAY.—The Director shall ensure that infor-
10 mation on how to access the toll-free hotline telephone
11 number is on display in public areas of Federal buildings
12 protected by the Federal Protective Service.
