Trans Digital Technologies Limited Liability Company received an award from The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) for the Credential Authentication Technology Boarding Pass Scanner System (CAT/BPSS). The contract is an Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract covering a base year and three option years. With notice of award, TDT also received the first Delivery Order under the contract, \$1,968,080.00, for low rate initial production systems and support, which covers a period of approximately five months and 10 units. CAT/BPSS is kiosk for a computerized system that will read and analyze data and embedded security features on airport passenger's identification and boarding pass to identify fraudulent identifications and boarding passes. TSA also made awards to BAE and NCR for the low rate initial production systems and support

Integrated Biometric Technology (IBT), LLC receives renewal of its prime contract for HazPrint every January 31st. Also IBT's subcontract with Lockheed Martin for the TWIC program is renewed every six months, approximately April/October.
