Truth in Testimony

House Rule XI, clause 2(g)(5): "Each committee shall, to the greatest extent practicable, require witnesses who appear before it to submit in advance written statements of proposed testimony and to limit their initial presentation to the committee to brief summaries thereof. 

Prior to joining the government, he spent nearly a decade in the private sector as a corporate lawyer advising clients on international mergers and acquisitions and capital markets transactions. A former US Army officer, he is a combat veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
