

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1129
OFFERED BY MR. CLARKE OF MICHIGAN

At the end of the bill add the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . EFFECTS OF HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT RE-**
2 **DUCTIONS ON EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS**
3 **AND RESPONSE CAPABILITIES.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Administrator of the Federal
5 Emergency Management Agency, in consultation of the
6 National Advisory Council established under section
7 508(a) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C.
8 318(a)), shall collect and compile information from cur-
9 rent and former Homeland Security Grant Program
10 grantees on the effects of reductions in Homeland Security
11 Grant Program funding on State and local emergency pre-
12 vention, mitigation, protection, response, and recovery ca-
13 pabilities since fiscal year 2010.

14 (b) **REPORT.**—Not later than 180 days after the date
15 of enactment of the Act, the Administrator shall—

16 (1) report to the Committee on Homeland Se-
17 curity of the House of Representatives and the Com-
18 mittee on Homeland Security and Governmental Af-
19 fairs of the Senate all information collected under
20 subsection (a); and

1 (2) include with such report—

2 (A) a description of existing gaps in core
3 capabilities identified in National Preparedness
4 Goal, a description of State and local homeland
5 security programs discontinued as a result of
6 Homeland Security Grant Program funding re-
7 ductions; and

8 (B) guidance for States and urban areas to
9 maintain the core capabilities achieved with
10 Homeland Security Grant Program funding
11 prior to fiscal year 2010 in light of funding re-
12 ductions.
