

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3116
OFFERED BY MR. DUNCAN OF SOUTH CAROLINA
(FOR HIMSELF AND MR. CLARKE OF MICHIGAN)**

At the end of title _____ add the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . FUTURE-YEARS HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 874 of the Homeland Se-
3 curity Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 454) is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 **“SEC. 874. FUTURE-YEARS HOMELAND SECURITY PRO-**
6 **GRAM.**

7 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than the 30 days fol-
8 lowing the date of each fiscal year on which the budget
9 of the President is submitted to Congress under section
10 1105(a) of title 31, United States Code, the Secretary
11 shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees
12 a future-years homeland security program that provides
13 detailed estimates of the projected expenditures and cor-
14 responding requests for appropriations included in that
15 budget. The future-years homeland security program shall
16 cover the fiscal year for which the budget is submitted
17 as well as the four succeeding fiscal years

1 “(b) CONSISTENCY OF BUDGET REQUEST WITH ES-
2 TIMATES OF NECESSARY EXPENDITURES AND APPRO-
3 PRIATIONS.—For each fiscal year, the Secretary shall en-
4 deavor to ensure that the projected amounts specified in
5 program and budget information submitted to Congress
6 in support of the President’s budget request are consistent
7 with the estimates for expenditures and proposed appro-
8 priations necessary to support the programs, projects, and
9 activities of the Department included in the budget pursu-
10 ant to section 1105(a) (5) of title 31, United States Code.

11 “(c) EXPLANATION OF ALIGNMENT WITH STRATE-
12 GIES AND PLANS.—Together with the detailed estimates
13 of the projected expenditures and corresponding requests
14 for appropriations submitted for the future years home-
15 land security program, the Secretary shall provide an ex-
16 planation of how those estimates and requests align with
17 the homeland security strategies and plans developed and
18 updated as appropriate by the Secretary.

19 “(d) PROJECTION OF ACQUISITION ESTIMATES.—
20 Each futures year homeland security funding program
21 shall project acquisition estimates for a period of 5 fiscal
22 years, with specified estimates for each fiscal year, for all
23 technology acquisitions within the Department and each
24 component therein, including refresh and sustainment ex-
25 penses, as well as the annual deployment schedule of any

1 acquisition with a total cost over the 5-fiscal-year period
2 estimated to exceed \$50,000,000.

3 “(e) CONTINGENCY AMOUNTS.—Nothing in this sec-
4 tion shall be construed as prohibiting the inclusion in the
5 future-years homeland security program of amounts for
6 management contingencies, subject to the requirements of
7 subsection (b).

8 “(f) AVAILABILITY OF INFORMATION TO THE PUB-
9 LIC.—The Secretary shall make available to the public in
10 electronic form the information required to be submitted
11 to Congress under this section, except those portions that
12 are deemed to be classified in nature under the parameters
13 of section 537 of the Department of Homeland Security
14 Appropriations Act, 2006 (6 U.S.C. 114).”.

15 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
16 in section 1(b) of such Act is amended by striking the
17 item relating to such section and inserting the following:

“Sec. 874. Future-years homeland security program.”.
