

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3116**

OFFERED BY *Mr. Thompson of Ms.*

Page 59, line 11, strike “domestic” and insert
“homegrown violent”.

Page 59, strike lines 15 through 20.

Page 59, line 21, strike “(4)” and insert “(3)”.

Page 60, line 1, strike section 404 and insert the
following:

1 **SEC. 404. COMPOSITION OF THE 9/11 REVIEW COMMISSION.**

2 (a) MEMBERS.—The 9/11 Review Commission shall
3 be composed of 10 members, of whom—

4 (1) 1 member shall be appointed by the Presi-
5 dent, who shall serve as chairman of the Commis-
6 sion;

7 (2) 1 member shall be appointed by the Speak-
8 er of the House of Representatives, who shall serve
9 as the vice chairman of the Commission;

10 (3) 2 members shall be appointed by the senior
11 member of the Senate leadership of the Democratic
12 Party;

1 (4) 2 members shall be appointed by the senior
2 member of the leadership of the House of Represent-
3 atives of the Republican Party;

4 (5) 2 members shall be appointed by the senior
5 member of the Senate leadership of the Republican
6 Party; and

7 (6) 2 members shall be appointed by the senior
8 member of the leadership of the House of Represent-
9 atives of the Democratic Party.

10 (b) QUALIFICATIONS; INITIAL MEETING.—

11 (1) POLITICAL PARTY AFFILIATION.—Not more
12 than 5 members of the Commission shall be from
13 the same political party.

14 (2) NONGOVERNMENTAL APPOINTEES.—An in-
15 dividual appointed to the Commission may not be an
16 officer or employee of the Federal Government or
17 any State or local government.

18 (3) OTHER QUALIFICATIONS.—It is the sense of
19 Congress that individuals appointed to the Commis-
20 sion should be prominent United States citizens,
21 with national recognition and significant depth of ex-
22 perience in such professions as governmental service,
23 law enforcement, the armed services, law, public ad-
24 ministration, intelligence gathering, commerce (in-
25 cluding aviation matters), and foreign affairs.

1 (4) INITIAL MEETING.—The Commission shall
2 meet and begin the operations of the Commission as
3 soon as practicable.

4 (c) QUORUM; VACANCIES.—After its initial meeting,
5 the Commission shall meet upon the call of the chairman
6 or a majority of its members. Six members of the Commis-
7 sion shall constitute a quorum. Any vacancy in the Com-
8 mission shall not affect its powers, but shall be filled in
9 the same manner in which the original appointment was
10 made.
