



### <u>The Biden-Mayorkas Border Crisis Breaks its Own Record—and Americans</u> <u>Across the Country are Paying for it</u>

AUGUST FY2023 ENCOUNTERS 232,972

AUGUST FY2022 ENCOUNTERS 204,087 AUGUST FY2021 ENCOUNTERS 209,840

- U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) reported 232,972 alien encounters along the Southwest Border (SWB) in August 2023.
- This is a 14% increase compared to last August. With one month remaining, encounters at the Southwest border in FY2023 have increased over 100% compared to all of FY2019.
  - Of these encounters, **181,059** individuals were apprehended attempting to cross illegally between ports of entry. This is a **36%** increase since the previous month.
  - This confirms a statement by **former Border Patrol Chief Raul Ortiz**, who briefed the Committee following the end of Title 42 and **said the decrease in illegal crossings is likely to be temporary**.
- Encounters by the Office of Field Operations (OFO) were the highest on record in August and increased 132% from August 2022.
  - Since the beginning of the FY23, **211,000** Cubans, Haitians, Nicaraguans, and Venezuelans have been granted parole under the administration's **CHNV** parole process at ports of entry nationwide.
- 45,400 inadmissible aliens were processed by OFO with CBP One app appointments in August. In July, Secretary Mayorkas expanded the number of daily admission to more than 1,450 per day via the app.
  - Almost all of these inadmissible aliens will ultimately be released into the interior, regardless of whether they are granted parole or claim asylum.
  - Following the end of Title 42, Secretary Mayorkas has utilized the expansion of the CBP One app to shift more, otherwise inadmissible aliens to ports of entry and make the chaos seem orderly.
- At the SW border in August 2023, 101,828 single adults, 116,721 family unit individuals, and 14,259 unaccompanied children were encountered along the Southwest border. Family unit encounters increased 35% compared to July 2023 and 125% compared to Aug. 2022.
  - So far this fiscal year, 151 individuals whose names appear on the terrorist watchlist were stopped trying to cross the U.S.-Mexico border between ports of entry.
  - This is a 54% increase from all FY22, and there is still one more month left in the fiscal year.

#### Criminal Cartels Had a Booming Business in August

- Since President Biden took office, there have been over 7 million encounters nationwide and 6 million encounters at the Southwest border, in addition to nearly 1.6 million known gotaways who evaded U.S. Border Patrol.
- In August, illegal crossings at the Southwest border averaged nearly 6,000 a day.
  - Since the beginning of Fiscal Year 2023, there have been over 2 million alien encounters at our Southwest border.
- So far in FY23, CBP has arrested 32,097 aliens with criminal convictions or outstanding warrants nationwide, including 564 known gang members, 167 of those being MS-13 members.
- In FY23 alone, CBP, including Air and Marine Operations, has seized 25,901 pounds of fentanyl, coming across the Southwest border—enough to kill around 6 billion people.
  - Notably, Federal officials estimate they are only able to seize 5-10% of all illegal drugs smuggled across the Southwest border.
- Since the **beginning of FY23**, **20,273 Chinese nationals** have been encountered along the Southwest border—a **831% increase in encounters compared to all of last fiscal year.**
- On August 8, Massachusetts Governor Maura Healey declared a state of emergency due to the influx of aliens.
- The next day, New York City Mayor Eric Adams stated the alien influx was "not sustainable," as around 100,000 aliens have come to the state of New York, mostly to New York City over the last year, according to Governor Kathy Hochul.
- On August 8, a group of **suspected cartel gunmen**, **armed with rifles and body armor**, were seen on cameras crossing illegally into the Fronton, Texas and were never located.
- In early August, with **close to 20,000 aliens in detention** at the SW border, DHS instructed Border Patrol sectors to **increase alien releases**.

#### The Northern Border Crisis is at a Historic High

AUGUST FY2023 ENCOUNTERS 19,835

AUGUST FY2022 ENCOUNTERS 15,260 AUGUST FY2021 ENCOUNTERS 4,456

- Encounters at the Northern border in August 2023 increased 345% compared to August 2021.
- Encounters along the busiest sector of the Northern border, the Swanton Sector, have increased nearly 2,200% compared to August 2021.
- 3 suspected terrorists have been stopped attempting to cross the Northern border between ports of entry this fiscal year.
