Dear Secretary Mayorkas:

I am in receipt of your responses to my August 16, 2023 and September 18, 2023 letters, declining to appear before the Committee on Homeland Security (Committee) to testify exclusively on the unprecedented border security crisis. I am writing again to reiterate my request.

The Committee recently completed its nearly year-long investigation into the border crisis. As the Department's Secretary, your testimony is vital to the Committee's oversight and to providing the American public with complete transparency and accountability.

Also, as you are aware, articles for your impeachment were filed in the House of Representatives and were referred to the Committee in November. Accordingly, we have initiated impeachment proceedings, of which your testimony will be a part.

As the House of Representatives' primary committee of jurisdiction for the Department, the Committee takes its responsibilities very seriously. I request your participation in an afternoon hearing on January 18, 2024.

I request and look forward to your response by January 10, 2024.
