### Biden Administration's Mass-Parole Shell Game Continues to Incentivize a Historic Influx at Ports of Entry



- U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) recorded 241,022 encounters nationwide in May, including 170,723 at the Southwest border (SWB). Nationwide encounters increased 21% compared to May of Fiscal Year (FY) 2021. These numbers remain well above what constituted a crisis for the Obama administration.
- Since President Biden and Secretary Mayorkas took office, there have been more than 9.7 million encounters nationwide and more than 7.9 million encounters at the Southwest border. By comparison, CBP recorded around 3.1 million such encounters nationwide from FY2017-2020.
- Additionally, roughly 2 million known gotaways have evaded Border Patrol agents since FY2021. In testimony before the Committee last year, then-chief of Border Patrol, Raul Ortiz, said the total number of gotaways could be undercounted by as much as 20%.
- Nationwide border encounters by the Office of Field Operations (OFO) at ports of entry (119,376) increased 16% last month compared to May 2023 and over 300% compared to May 2021.
- Nearly half of all nationwide encounters in May were recorded by OFO. In comparison, only 12% of all encounters were at ports of entry in May 2021.
- 44,500 inadmissible aliens with CBP One app appointments were processed by OFO in May. Since January 2023, 636,600 individuals have scheduled appointments with the app. 95.8 percent of all inadmissible aliens who scheduled appointments through the app from January-September 2023 were ultimately released into the United States on parole.
- Since the program began, 462,100 Cubans, Haitians, Nicaraguans, and Venezuelans have been mass paroled under the administration's CHNV parole program at ports of entry.
- Since Jan. 20, 2021, DHS has paroled more than 2.18 million inadmissible aliens into the interior (not counting Ukrainian/Afghan refugees), and released roughly 2 million more with Notices to Appear (NTAs).
- At the SW border in May 2024, CBP encountered 97,205 single adults, 64,724 family unit individuals, and 8,642 unaccompanied children.

#### May Northern Border Encounters Reach Another Fiscal Year High

- Encounters at the northern border in May marked their third highest monthly total on record.
   Encounters increased 1,188% compared to May of FY21 and increased 10% compared to May 2023.
- For the third month in a row, apprehensions along the busiest sector of the northern border, the Swanton Sector, hit their highest monthly total on CBP record (2,911). Apprehensions at this sector increased 6,368% compared to May of FY21 and 534% compared to May of FY23.
- According to former Border Patrol chief Mark Morgan, "The northern border is under-resourced by far compared to the Southwest border."

# Alarms Blinking Red: The National Security Cost of Biden and Mayorkas' Open Border

- In May 2024, 10 more individuals whose names appear on the terrorist watchlist were stopped trying to cross the U.S.-Mexico border between ports of entry. Since FY21, 372 of these individuals have been caught crossing our Southwest border illegally.
- So far this fiscal year, CBP has arrested 26,384 aliens with criminal convictions or outstanding warrants nationwide, including 349 known gang members, 49 of those being MS-13 members.
- Since the beginning of FY24, CBP, including Air and Marine Operations (AMO), has seized 13,411 pounds of fentanyl coming across the Southwest border—enough to kill over 3 billion people.
- So far in FY24, 31,077 Chinese nationals have been encountered illegally crossing the Southwest border between ports of entry. Illegal encounters of Chinese nationals in May 2024 increased over 11,000% compared to May 2021 and FY24 encounters have surpassed all of last fiscal year.
- This fiscal year alone, the Border Patrol has released more than 801,000 illegal aliens with a Notice to Appear (NTA) into our communities. OFO has recorded another 357,000 NTAs.
- On May 28, Secretary Mayorkas admitted to CBS News that some inadmissible aliens coming to the Southwest border are trying to "game" the asylum system.
- On May 3, two Jordanian nationals, alleged to be in the United States unlawfully, attempted to breach
  Marine Corps Base Quantico. At least one of the individuals had entered illegally through the
  Southwest border and one was on the terrorist watch list.
- On May 23, an illegal alien from Turkey **told Fox News** he was shocked it was so easy to cross the Southwest border and that **Americans should be "worried" about who else is getting in.**
- On May 13, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) admitted that last year Border Patrol
  apprehended and released an illegal alien in Arizona who was convicted for aggravated murder in
  Colombia.
