



The Biden-Harris Administration Puts its Catch-and-Release Agenda on Full Display

- U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) recorded 205,019 encounters nationwide in June, including 130,419 at the Southwest border (SWB). These numbers remain well above what constituted a crisis for the Obama administration.
- Nationwide encounters this fiscal year have increased 5% compared to this time last fiscal year and 90% compared to this time in Fiscal Year (FY) 2021.
- Since President Biden, Secretary Mayorkas, and border czar Vice President Harris took office, there have been more than 9.9 million encounters nationwide and more than 8.1 million encounters at the Southwest border. By comparison, CBP recorded around 3.1 million such encounters nationwide from FY2017-2020.
- Nationwide border encounters by the Office of Field Operations (OFO) at ports of entry (117,411) surpassed 100,000 for the 14th month in a row and increased 6% last month compared to June 2023 and over 300% compared to June 2021.
- Over half of all nationwide encounters in June were recorded by OFO. In comparison, only 14% of all encounters were at ports of entry in June 2021.
- 41,800 inadmissible aliens with CBP One app appointments were processed by OFO in June. Since January 2023, 680,500 individuals have scheduled appointments with the app. 95.8 percent of all inadmissible aliens who scheduled appointments through the app from January-September 2023 were ultimately released into the United States on parole.
- Since the program began, 494,799 Cubans, THE BIDEN ADMINISTRATION'S SHELL GAME Haitians, Nicaraguans, and Venezuelans have been **mass paroled** under the administration's CHNV parole program at ports of entry.
- Via just these two unlawful mass-parole programs alone, the Biden-Harris administration has released more than 1 million inadmissible aliens into the United States.
- At the SW border in June 2024, CBP encountered 75,923 single adults, 46,953 family unit individuals, and 7,427 unaccompanied children.

June Swanton Sector Apprehensions Reach Another Fiscal Year High

- Encounters at the northern border in June marked their fifth highest monthly total on CBP record. Encounters increased more than 800% compared to June FY21.
- For the **fourth month in a row**, apprehensions along the busiest sector of the northern border, **the Swanton Sector, hit their highest monthly total on CBP record (3,309).**
- Apprehensions at this sector increased over 6,000% compared to June of FY21 and over 400% compared to June FY23.

The Public Safety Cost of the Biden-Harris Open Border

- Since FY21, 375 individuals whose names appear on the terrorist watchlist have been stopped trying to cross the U.S.-Mexico border *between ports of entry.*
- Additionally, roughly 2 million known gotaways have evaded Border Patrol agents since FY2021.
- In testimony before the Committee last year, then-chief of Border Patrol, Raul Ortiz, said the total number of gotaways could be undercounted by as much as 20%.
- So far this fiscal year, CBP has arrested 28,611 aliens with criminal convictions or outstanding warrants nationwide, including 404 known gang members, 57 of those being MS-13 members.
- Since the beginning of FY24, **CBP**, including **Air and Marine Operations** (AMO), has **seized 14,760** pounds of fentanyl coming across the Southwest border—enough to kill over 3 billion people.
- So far in FY24, **33,242 Chinese nationals** have been encountered **illegally crossing** the Southwest border *between ports of entry.* **Illegal encounters of Chinese nationals in June 2024 increased over 2,000% compared to June 2021, and FY24 encounters have surpassed all of last fiscal year.**
- This fiscal year alone, the Border Patrol and CBP have released more than 1.2 million illegal aliens with a Notice to Appear (NTA) into our communities.
- On June 17, Victor Antonio Martinez Hernandez was arrested for the murder of a Maryland mother of five, Rachel Morin. Martinez was already wanted for murder in El Salvador when he illegally crossed the Southwest border and later committed a home invasion in Los Angeles.
- On June 21, Johan Jose Martinez-Rangel and Franklin Pena, both inadmissible aliens from Venezuela, were charged with the murder of Jocelyn Nungaray, a 12-year-old girl from Houston, Texas.
- On June 27, two Chick-fil-A workers in Irving, Texas, were shot and killed by Oved Bernardo Mendoza Argueta, an inadmissible alien from El Salvador.
