
### More Than 1.3 Million Inadmissable Aliens Mass-Paroled Under Biden & Harris' CBP One, CHNV Programs



- U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) recorded 158,988 encounters nationwide in August including 107,503 at the Southwest border (SWB).
- SWB encounters in August increased 3.3% from July encounters. Southwest border encounters this Fiscal Year (FY) are up 31% compared to this time in FY2021.
- Since President Biden and his "border czar," Vice President Harris took office there have been more than 10.3 million encounters nationwide, including more than 8.3 million encounters at the Southwest border. By contrast, CBP recorded around 3.1 million encounters nationwide from FY2017-2020.
- Of the 158,988 nationwide encounters in August, 62% were at ports of entry, while only 15% of nationwide encounters were at ports of entry in August 2021.
- 44,700 inadmissible aliens with CBP One app appointments were processed by OFO in August.
- Since January 2023, 813,000 otherwise inadmissible aliens have scheduled appointments through the app. 95.8 percent of all inadmissible aliens who scheduled appointments through the app from January-September 2023 were ultimately released into the United States on parole.
- Since the program began, 530,000 Cubans, Haitians, Nicaraguans, and Venezuelans have been mass paroled under the administration's CHNV parole program at ports of entry.
- In July 2024, DHS suspended the unlawful (CHNV) parole program after an internal review revealed widespread fraud in the program. They resumed the program just weeks later. In September 2024, a Haitian national who was paroled into the U.S. last year was arrested for raping a 10-year-old boy who lived next door to him in Mansfield, Massachusetts.
- Via just the unlawful CHNV mass-parole program and the CBP One scheme, the Biden-Harris administration has released more than 1.3 million inadmissible aliens into the United States.
- At the SW border in August 2024, CBP encountered 64,234 single adults, 36,016 family unit individuals, and 7,130 unaccompanied children.
- 382 illegal aliens on the terrorist watchlist have been apprehended between ports of entry at the Southwest border since FY2021.

### The Northern Border Crisis Rages On

- Encounters at the northern border in August marked their second highest monthly total on record. Encounters increased more than 300% compared to August FY2021.
- Northern border encounters this fiscal year have surpassed all of FY2021 and FY2022 combined.
- Apprehensions along the busiest sector of the northern border, the Swanton Sector (2,198) increased nearly 7,000% last month compared to August of FY2021 and over 200% compared to August of FY2023.

#### The Biden-Harris Open Border is a Public-Safety Catastrophe

- Throughout the month of August, reports stated members of the Venezuelan gang Tren de Aragua
  had brutally taken over multiple apartment complexes in Aurora, Colorado. Jhonardy Jose PachecoChirino, the alleged 'shot-caller' of the gang crossed Southwest border in 2022, was caught and
  released into the United States. At least one of these alleged gang members entered the U.S. using
  the CBP One App.
- Roughly 2 million known gotaways have evaded Border Patrol agents since FY2021. In testimony
  before the Committee last year, then-chief of Border Patrol, Raul Ortiz, said the total number of
  gotaways could be underreported by as much as 20%.
- So far this fiscal year, CBP has arrested 33,379 aliens with criminal convictions or outstanding warrants nationwide, including 478 known gang members, 64 of those being MS-13 members.
- In August, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) arrested a Haitian national who entered the U.S. in June 2023 via the CHNV mass-parole program. In March, he was charged with the rape of a 15-year-old girl in a migrant shelter in Boston.
- On August 11 in Coney Island, New York, **Nicaraguan national Daniel Davon-Bonilla raped and assaulted** a 46-year-old woman. Davon-Bonilla crossed the Southwest border through Eagle Pass, Texas, on December 7, 2022, **and was caught by Border Patrol agents.**
- A Senegalese national, who was released into the U.S. after illegaly crossing the Southwest border, was arrested in August for the rape a 36-year-old woman in the South Bronx, NY.
- On August 13, ICE apprehended Marc Kervens Beauvais following his arrest for allegedly raping a
  pregnant woman at a Massachusetts migrant hotel. Beauvais was arrested and subsequently
  released by the Border Patrol on June 26, 2021, after he crossed illegally near Del Rio, Texas.
- On August 13, Peruvian gang leader, Gianfranco Torres-Navarro, wanted for the murder of at least 23
  people was arrested in New York three months after he was caught and released at the SW border
  in Texas.
