CBP Records More Than 140,000 Encounters Nationwide to Start FY2025



- Since the start of Fiscal Year (FY) 2021, Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has recorded more than **10.9 million encounters nationwide**, including more than **8.8 million at the Southwest border**.
- CBP encountered **62,897 single adults**, **36,718 family unit individuals**, **and 6,604 unaccompanied alien children** (UACs) at the Southwest border. UAC apprehensions increased from September.
- Of the 143,050 nationwide encounters in October, 59% were at ports of entry (84,921), while only 15% of nationwide encounters were at ports of entry in FY2021. This shows that the Biden-Harris administration has knowingly encouraged inadmissible aliens to simply enter at ports instead of between them.
- 44,900 inadmissible aliens with CBP One app appointments were processed by the Office of Field Operations (OFO) in October. Since January 2023, more than 860,000 otherwise-inadmissible aliens have scheduled appointments through the app.
- 95.8 percent of all inadmissible aliens who scheduled appointments through the CBP One app from January-September 2023 were ultimately released into the United States on parole.
- Since the program began, 531,620 Cubans, Haitians, Nicaraguans, and Venezuelans have been mass-paroled under the administration's CHNV parole program.
- In July 2024, DHS paused the unlawful CHNV program after an internal review revealed widespread fraud in the sponsorship portion of the program. It was resumed just weeks later, however.
- The Biden-Harris administration has released roughly **1.4 million inadmissible aliens** into the United States just via the unlawful CHNV mass-parole program and the CBP One scheme.
- In October FY2025, **1,288 Chinese nationals were apprehended at the Southwest border—an increase from September.** For comparison, 5,650 were apprehended from FY2017-FY2020 *combined*.
- An HHS whistleblower recently testified to the committee that the Biden-Harris administration's policies "have delivered these unaccompanied alien children to criminals, traffickers and members of transnational criminal organizations..."
- 394 illegal aliens on the terrorist watchlist have been apprehended between ports of entry at the Southwest and northern borders since FY2021.
 Only 14 were apprehended from FY2017-FY2020.

The Open Border Has Given Foreign Criminals, National Security Threats a Foothold on U.S. Soil

- Roughly 2 million known gotaways have evaded Border Patrol agents since FY2021. Then-chief of Border Patrol, Raul Ortiz, said the total number of gotaways could be underreported by as much as 20%.
- Since FY2021, Border Patrol agents have recorded 56,154 arrests of aliens with criminal convictions or outstanding warrants nationwide. For comparison, Border Patrol arrested 21,936 from FY2017-FY2020.
- Since FY2021, **9,254** pounds of fentanyl have been seized between ports of entry nationwide by Border Patrol agents, compared to just 1,604 pounds from FY2017-FY2020.
- On October 28, Fox News revealed that one in every 10 inmates in Houston, Texas, have an ICE hold. 43% of these cases involve violent crimes. Among these cases, there are 75 murder cases and 174 sexual assault cases.
- On October 30, the *New York Post* revealed the illegal alien who shot a Jewish man near a synagogue in Chicago had been screened at the Southwest border by CBP and released with a **Notice to Appear.** The screening process found him to supposedly pose no threat to public safety.
- According to a Fox News report, confirmed by a government official, there are currently 1.4 million illegal immigrants in the interior who have been given final orders of removal from an immigration judge who have not been deported yet. Only 13,000 of these aliens are currently in ICE custody.
- On October 29, NewsNation revealed the three capital murder suspects affiliated with the Venezuelan gang Tren de Aragua had been apprehended crossing the border and were released from CBP custody with a Notice to Appear.
- On October 31 in Laredo, Texas, state troopers apprehended a human smuggler traveling with 10 illegal immigrants, two of whom were children under 10 years old.

The Historic Northern Border Crisis Continues

- Northern border encounters in October increased more than 300% compared to October FY2022 (3,728).
- Apprehensions along the busiest sector of the northern border, the Swanton Sector (1,025) increased more than 2,000% in October compared to October FY2022.
- Since FY2021, 7 illegal aliens on the terrorist watchlist have been apprehended crossing the northern border.
