<u>President Trump Delivers the Most Secure Border in US History</u>

- U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) nationwide border encounters in June (25,228) decreased nearly 88%, and Southwest border encounters (9,036) dropped 93%, compared to June 2024.
- Border Patrol apprehensions between ports of entry at the Southwest border last month (6,072) decreased by nearly 93% compared to June 2024 (83,532). On June 28, Border Patrol apprehended just 136 illegal aliens—the lowest day of apprehensions in USBP history.
- CBP encounters of inadmissible aliens at the Northern border dropped nearly 67% in June 2025 (5,833) compared to June 2024 (17,700).
- After President Trump ended Biden's unlawful mass-parole schemes, encounters at ports of entry nationwide dropped 85% in June (17,204) compared to June 2024 (117,326).
- Encounters of unaccompanied alien children (UACs) at the SWB dropped by 90% last month (678) compared to June 2024 (7,428).
- In June, fentanyl seizures nationwide (742 lbs.) increased 3% from the previous month and decreased 48% compared to June 2024 (1,427). The Coast Guard has seized more than 240,000 pounds of cocaine since the start of the Trump administration.
- For the second month in a row in June, **zero inadmissible aliens were released by USBP** into American communities.
- An average of 47,000 illegal aliens have been deported each month under President Trump.
 Since January, DHS has removed 600 known or suspected terrorists from the interior.
- A new Cygnal poll has found 60% of Americans support mass deportations, including 50% of Hispanics surveyed.
