July Was a Win For Homeland Security and a Loss For Cartels, Traffickers, & Sanctuary-City Policies

- U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) nationwide border encounters in July (24,628) decreased over 85%, and Southwest border encounters (7,382) dropped nearly 93% compared to July 2024. This is the lowest monthly total in CBP history, breaking the previous record set last month.
- U.S. Border Patrol apprehensions between ports of entry at the Southwest border last month
 (4,601) decreased by nearly 92% compared to July 2024 (56,400). On July 20, the Border Patrol
 apprehended just 116 illegal aliens—the lowest single-day total in agency history. Meanwhile, traffic
 along the deadly Darien Gap, a crowded human smuggling route under previous administrations, has
 almost completely halted.
- CBP encounters of inadmissible aliens at the Northern border dropped nearly 65% in July 2025 (6,296) compared to July 2024 (17,895).
- Following President Trump's reversal of Biden's unlawful mass-parole schemes earlier this year, inadmissible encounters at ports of entry nationwide dropped 83% in July (18,451) compared to July 2024 (110,525).
- Fentanyl seizures nationwide (968 lbs.) increased 30% from the previous month. Meanwhile, in the interior, the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) has seized approximately 44 million fentanyl pills, 4,500 pounds of fentanyl powder, nearly 65,000 pounds of methamphetamine, more than 201,500 pounds of cocaine, and made over 2,105 fentanyl-related arrests since the beginning of the Trump administration.
- For the third month in a row in July, zero inadmissible aliens were released by USBP into American communities, compared to the 12,365 inadmissible aliens that were released under Joe Biden last July.
- The Trump administration has located over 13,000 of the 320,000+ unaccompanied alien children who were lost by the Biden-Harris administration, and HHS has analyzed more than 59,000 of the 65,000 backlogged reports on these children
- An average of 47,000 illegal aliens have been deported each month_under
 President Trump. As of May 2025, ICE has arrested over 750 illegal aliens convicted of murder. Meanwhile, attacks against ICE officers and agents are up 1,000%.
